

The Department of Global Business Leadership at the College of Saint Benedict and Saint John's University invites applications for a position as a tenure track assistant professor of quantitative business applications to begin in August of 2012. The person hired will teach quantitative tools and techniques for business decision making for both the introductory (sophomore) level as well as upper level courses. An M.B.A., M.I.S., or M.S. is required for this position and a doctorate is preferred. Global business background, academic or experiential is desirable.

The College of Saint Benedict, a liberal arts college for women and Saint John's University, a liberal arts college for men, are located four miles apart in Central Minnesota just outside metropolitan St. Cloud and 70 miles from Minneapolis. APPLICATION PROCESS: Applications are accepted on line only. Applicants must complete a faculty application form and attach a cover letter, curriculum vitae, a statement of teaching philosophy, evidence of teaching effectiveness.

You will also be required to submit 3 letters of reference. On the reference screen, you will be asked to list 3 names and email address. If you use a placement service, you will need to contact them to request the email address to list. The system will then automatically send an email to your letter writer or placement service requesting a letter of reference for you.

Review of applications will begin on October 15th, and the position will remain open until filled.
