Augsburg University's Department of Physician Assistant Studies is expanding to meet the healthcare needs of our region. We are in search of PA candidates who possess a clear commitment to diversity and inclusion, have experience in clinical education, and have a demonstrated understanding of the unique needs of physician assistant practice, particularly within medically underserved communities.

This is a full-time, 12-month, non-tenure track, clinical education faculty appointment, to begin on or around June 1, 2018. This dynamic position includes clinical site coordination, clinical partner development, student advising, and classroom teaching. The position offers the potential for clinical practice release time and a highly competitive salary (commensurate with experience) in the PA education sector. The applicant must be a NCCPA-certified Physician Assistant with clinical experience as a PA and must possess, at minimum, a master's degree. Candidates who are licensed as MD/DO or PharmDs will also be considered. Prior experience in an academic setting is preferred.
